

Snap Care: Recommended Wage Rates

At Snap Care, we recruit skilled professionals who offer more than basic care - supporting children, young people and adults with their therapy and rehabilitation goals, education, independence, and quality of life. We monitor market trends to ensure clients attract and retain high-calibre candidates. Rates vary by role and client requirements. To guide decisions, we outline typical experience levels for each wage bracket.

Additional Notes:

- Night Rate: 10:00pm to 6:00am
- Weekend Rate: 10:00pm Friday to 6:00am Monday
- Weekends typically attract an additional £2.00 gross per hour, but please speak with one of our recruiters as this can vary from job to job
- Spilt shifts: Wrap around support, before and/or after school roles. etc, attract an additional £1.00 to £2.00 gross per hour
- Experience is a minimum of one year except for senior roles/ otherwise stated
- Where more than one child is being looked after in nanny roles, attract + £1.00 to £2.00 gross per hour.
- Live-in roles providing full-time accommodation deduct £2.00 gross per hour
- All hourly rates are quoted gross and do not include Employer's NIC, or Pension Contributions
- Employment is on a PAYE basis, not self-employed

Night Carers

<u>Sleeping Night Carer</u>: A Sleeping Night Carer should expect to be able to sleep unless there's an emergency. Reverts to On-Call or Waking Night Rate as appropriate if support is required.

Candidate Experience: Support Worker Experience as appropriate to the client's needs Rates: London: £12.21 | Home Counties/Southeast: £12.21 | All Other Regions: £12.21

<u>On-Call Night Carer:</u> An On-call (Also known as a 'Sleep-in'), the On-call Night Carer is likely to attend to the client once or twice for periods of 20 minutes or less, or 1 time of 30 minutes or less. Reverts to a Waking Night rate if exceeded. May be on shift with a Waking Night Carer to assist as and when required.

Candidate Experience: Night Care Experience. Experience as appropriate to the client's needs

<u>Waking Night Carer, Senior:</u> Awake all night attending to the client, consistent monitoring, vital sign observations

Candidate Experience: 1 year+ Waking Night Experience, appropriate to the client's needs. Sleep Hygiene knowledge

Rates: London: £18.80 | Home Counties/Southeast: £18.30 | All Other Regions: £17.80



Waking Night Carer: Awake all night attending to the client, consistent monitoring, vital sign observations

Candidate Experience: Up to 1 year Waking night experience or On-Call Night Experience. Will initially need guidance,

training, and supervision.

24-Hour Live-in Support

<u>24-Hour Live-in Support:</u> Work shifts such as 7 days on/off, or 4 days on/off etc.

Candidate Experience: Support Worker/Care Experience as appropriate to the client.

Rates: The rate is determined by how many hours the support worker is working or not working/on-call, and the

complexity of the support required.

Professional Support Workers

<u>SEN Assistant:</u> Including Parent's Help (formally known as Mother's/Father's Help), Buddy, Trainee team member.

Provides additional support (shared care), this is not a sole charge role.

Candidate Experience: Limited/no professional experience. Initially needs guidance, training, and supervision.

Professional Support Worker Including Personal Assistants, Healthcare Assistants, Buddy/Mentor

Candidate Experience: Support Worker Experience as appropriate to the client.

<u>Complex Professional Support Worker</u> Including Personal Assistants (PA), Healthcare Assistants, Buddy/Mentor. **Candidate Experience:** Complex Healthcare experience that may include PEG, suctioning, oxygen administration,

epilepsy/seizure management etc.

Team Leaders

<u>Care Team Leader</u> Manages a home care team. Duties can include rota management, supervision, medication stock, equipment management, care plan management etc. Plus, hands on client support.

Nannies, Mannies

SEN/D Nanny/Manny, Senior. Supports a child with a disability or additional needs. Looks after siblings too, as appropriate to the needs of the main child.

Candidate Experience: One year+ sole charge professional nanny experience in a private household + SEN experience including complex care, behavioural, SEMH, neurodivergent, etc.

Rates: London: £21.00 | Home Counties/Southeast: £20.50 | All Other Regions: £20.00

SEN/D Nanny/Manny Supports a child with a disability or additional needs. Looks after siblings too, as appropriate to the needs of the main child.

Candidate Experience: Up to 1 year's nannying experience and/or 1:1 childcare experience, for example, within an SEN school.

<u>Specialist Nanny/Manny, Senior</u>. Supports and enables a parent to care for their child/children. Looks after siblings too, as appropriate to the needs of the main child.

Candidate Experience: One year+ sole charge professional nanny/childcare experience in a private household, that may include proxy parenting, + SEN experience including behavioural, SEMH, neurodivergent, etc.

Rates: London: £21.00 | Home Counties/Southeast: £20.50 | All Other Regions: £20.00

<u>Rota Nanny/Manny</u> (e.g. 7 days on/off, or 14 days on/off) Is effectively on-call for the duration. Requires a minimum of 2 hours free per 24 hours.

Candidate Experience: Experienced rota nanny/manny with relevant SEN experience.

Rates: All regions: £75k – £95k+ annual salary



<u>Rota Nanny/Manny (First Job)</u> (e.g. 7 days on/off, or 4 days on/off) Is effectively on-call for the duration. Requires a minimum of 2 hours free per 24 hours. Typically, 2 Rota Nannies/Mannies are employed to work to cover all shifts. **Candidate Experience:** Experienced nanny/manny with relevant SEN experience.

Rates: All regions: £55k – £75k+ annual salary

Educational Support

Governess/Governor Educational focus in addition to nannying tasks

Candidate Experience: Sole charge and childcare/nannying experience in a private household + SEN +

education/teaching background.

Tutors 1:1 Educational tutoring. Typically, short shifts 2-3 hours
