Additional Rate Information

- Night Rate: 10:00pm to 6:00am
- Weekend Rate: 10:00pm Friday to 6:00am Monday
- Experience is a minimum of one year except for senior roles/ otherwise stated
- Minimum shift length is 4 hours
- *Enhanced Bank Holiday Rates = Christmas Day, Boxing Day, and New Years Day. Day starts at midnight.

Buyout Fees: We offer a temp-to-perm option, giving you the chance to work with a candidate through our fully managed service before deciding to employ them directly through our recruitment service.

If you'd like to move a candidate to a direct contract, just let us know in writing – and it will need to be agreed by the candidate too.

A buyout fee applies if you go ahead:

- £4,000.00 + VAT per candidate if the move happens between 3 and 6 months from their start date
- £2,500.00 + VAT per candidate if it's after 6 months

Descriptions of Support Roles: Rates are defined by the role and the client's needs/experience required. Below is a description of each role.

Night Carers: **Sleeping Night Carer:** A Sleeping Night Carer should expect to be able to sleep unless there's an emergency. Moves to On-Call or Waking Night Rate if support need increase.

Candidate Experience: Support Worker Experience as appropriate to the client's needs

On-Call Night Carer: An On-call (Also known as a 'Sleep-in'), the On-Night Carer is likely to attend to the client once or twice for periods of 20 minutes or less, or 1 time of 30 minutes or less. Reverts to a Waking Night rate if exceeded. May be on shift with a Waking Night Carer to assist as required.

Candidate Experience: Night Care Experience. Experience as appropriate to the client's needs

Waking Night Carer Senior: Awake all night attending to the client, consistent monitoring, vital sign observations

Candidate Experience: Waking Night Experience, appropriate to the client's needs. Sleep Hygiene knowledge

Waking Night Carer: Awake all night attending to the client, consistent monitoring, vital sign observations

Candidate Experience: On-Call Night Experience +. Will initially need guidance, training, and supervision.

24-Hour Live-in Support: **24-Hour Live-in Support:** Work shifts such as 4,7, or 14 days on/off.

Candidate Experience: Support Worker/Care Experience as appropriate to the client.

Professional Support Workers:

Complex Professional Support Worker Including Personal Assistants (PA), Healthcare Assistants, Buddy/Mentor.

Candidate Experience: Complex Healthcare experience that may include PEG, suctioning, oxygen administration, epilepsy/seizure management etc.

Professional Support Worker Including Personal Assistants, Healthcare Assistants, Buddy/Mentor

Candidate Experience: Support Worker Experience as appropriate to the client.

SEN Assistant: Including Parent's Help (formally known as Mother's/Father's Help), Buddy, Trainee team member. Provides additional support (shared care), this is not a sole charge role.

Candidate Experience: Limited/no professional experience. Initially needs guidance, training, and supervision.

Team Leaders: Care Team Leader Manages a home care team. Duties can include rota management, supervision, medication stock, equipment management, care plan management etc. Plus, hands on client support.

Candidate Experience: 5+ years SEN/Disability experience incl. at least 1 year in team leadership and administration.

Assistant/Deputy Team Leader Assisting/covering the Care Team Leader, as above

Candidate Experience: 3+ years support experience plus administrative experience.

Nannies, Mannies: SEN/D Nanny/Manny Senior. Supports a child with a disability or additional needs. Looks after siblings too, as appropriate to the needs of the main child.

Candidate Experience: Sole charge professional nanny experience in a private household + SEN experience including complex care, behavioural, SEMH, neurodivergent, etc.

SEN/D Nanny/Manny Supports a child with a disability or additional needs. Looks after siblings too, as appropriate to the needs of the main child.

Candidate Experience: 1:1 childcare experience, for example, within an SEN school.

Specialist Nanny/Manny Senior. Supports and enables a parent to care for their child/children. Looks after siblings too, as appropriate to the needs of the main child.

Candidate Experience: Sole charge professional nanny/childcare experience in a private household, that may include proxy parenting, + SEN experience including behavioural, SEMH, neurodivergent, etc.
